RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of an Engineering Services Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,520,753.00 for the Meacham Boulevard Roadway Improvements Project (City Project No.103272).

DISCUSSION:

This Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) will authorize the execution of an Engineering Services Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. in the amount of \$1,520,753.00 for the Meacham Boulevard Roadway Improvements Project (City Project No.103272).

The Engineering Services Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc., includes design plans and specifications for Meacham Boulevard (City Project No. 103272) between Interstate Highway 35W and Blue Mound Road (FM 156). The contract scope for this project includes widening the roadway to a 5-lane undivided thoroughfare and adding pedestrian railing and sidewalks over the Burlington Northern Santa Fe bridge. The project will include right-of-way acquisition, drainage improvements, pedestrian facilities, street lights and coordination with the Texas Department of Transportation.
