(CD 7) Authorize the Temporary Closure of Heritage Trace Boulevard, Suttonridge Drive, and Laneyvale Drive between Park Drive and Copley Avenue from June 24, 2022 to August 18, 2022 for Construction Activities

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the temporary closure of Heritage Trace Boulevard, Suttonridge Drive, and Laneyvale Drive between Park Drive and Copley Avenue from June 24, 2022 to August 18, 2022 for construction activities.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Fort Worth Transportation and Public Works Department (TPW) requests the temporary closure of Heritage Trace Boulevard, Suttonridge Drive, and Laneyvale Drive between Park Drive and Copley Avenue for installation of a 24-inch water main (City Project Number 103505). The water main will need to be installed before construction of the remaining half of the residential access roadway to be constructed later this year. Also, the line will need to cross Suttonridge Drive at three locations and the closure is necessary as the waterline excavations are up to 20-ft deep and therefore require trench shoring devices. Concrete pavement panel demolition will also require full panel replacements. This area is presently undergoing new development construction and streets are used primarily by construction vehicles for construction purposes.

Traffic control plans for this project have been previously accepted.
