#### ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A PORTION OF HAGLER AVENUE, BETWEEN FOREST PARK BOULEVARD AND WAYSIDE STREET, LOCATED IN THE J. ASBURY SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 50, CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 63, PAGES 59 AND 60, PLAT **RECORDS.** TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 3,175 SQUARE FEET OR 0.073 OF LAND MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF FEE IN SAID LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN **CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH,

**TEXAS:** 

#### **SECTION 1.**

That a portion of Hagler Avenue, a twenty-six foot wide right-of-way, located between

Forest Park Boulevard and Wayside Street, located in the J. Asbury Survey, Abstract No. 50, as

recorded in Volume 63, Pages 59 and 60 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas and containing 3,175 square feet or 0.073 acre of land more or less, and as more specifically described in Exhibits A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

#### **SECTION 2.**

That the easement to the land in the above-described vacated right-of-way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

#### **SECTION 3.**

All existing utility easements be shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.
