(CD 9 / Future CD 9) Authorize Execution of a Contract with Texas Materials Group, Inc., dba Texas Bit, in the Amount of \$4,568,805.04 for the 2023 Downtown Resurfacing Project

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a contract with Texas Materials Group, Inc., dba Texas Bit, in the amount of \$4,568,805.04 for the 2023 Downtown Resurfacing project (City Project No. 104184).

DISCUSSION:

The Fiscal Year 2023 Pay-Go Contract Street Maintenance Program groups various types of street maintenance into specific contract packages. This contract provides for the resurfacing of streets in downtown at various locations as outlined on the attached project map. Upon completion of the project, there will be no anticipated impact on the General Fund operating budget.

This project was advertised for bid on September 22, 2022 and September 29, 2022 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On October 20, 2022, the following bids were received:

Funding is budgeted in the TPW Highway & Streets Department's General Capital Projects Fund for the purpose of funding the 2023 Downtown Resurfacing project, as appropriated.

MWBE – Texas Materials Group, Inc. is in compliance with the City's Business Equity Ordinance by committing to 20% Business Equity participation on this project. The City's Business Equity goal on this project is 20%.

This project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICT 9.

FISCAL INFORMATION / CERTIFICATION:

The Director of Finance certifies that funds are available in the current capital budget, as previously appropriated, in the General Capital Projects Fund for the 2023 Downtown Resurfacing project to support the approval of the above recommendation and execution of the contract. Prior to any expenditure being incurred, the Transportation and Public Works Department has the responsibility to validate the availability of funds.

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
