SUBJECT: CENTRAL LIBRARY HOURS REDUCTION

To the Mayor and Members of the City Council

The purpose of this IR is to inform City Council about a change of public hours coming to the Central Library. On Tuesday January 31, 2023 the Central Library will move from being open 7 days per week to 5. The library will be open Tuesdays-Saturdays 10am-6pm. Reduction of hours is part of the Fort Worth Public Library's drawdown of service in anticipation of closure.

Property Management continues to explore spaces in the downtown for a library presence and the size of the new location will determine the programs and services offered. The library welcomes suggestions for locations.
