RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the rejection of the bid received for Trinity River Vision, Phase 1 project - Unit 1: Part 10 – Channel Segment A; Water and Sanitary Sewer Relocations and Unit 2: Grand Avenue Bypass Storm Drain and North Laterals (City Project No. C00969).

DISCUSSION:

On November 24 and December 1, 2022, the Trinity River Vision, Phase 1 project - Unit 1: Part 10 – Channel Segment A; Water and Sanitary Sewer Relocations and Unit 2: Grand Avenue Bypass Storm Drain and North Laterals (City Project No C00969) Project was advertised in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On January 12, 2023, the following bid was received.

S.J. Louis Construction of Texas, Ltd.	\$38,877,087.50

The bid amount far exceeds the engineer's opinion of probable construction cost and city budget, therefore, staff recommends rejection of the bid.

Staff will review the project plans and specifications and make modifications in an attempt to reduce construction costs and increase interest from the contracting community. Staff intends to re-advertise the project for bids in the near future.
