AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A PORTION OF A VARIABLE WIDTH RIGHT OF WAY KNOWN AS WEST VICKERY BOULEVARD, SITUATED IN THE SARAH JENNINGS SURVEY, ABSTRACT 844, AS DEDICATED BY LOT 1, BLOCK 1, JENNINGS NORTH ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN CABINET B, SLIDE 484, OF THE PLAT RECORDS OF TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, AND LOT 1, BLOCK 2, HEMPHILL LAMAR ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDS THEREOF, RECORDED UNDER INSTRUMENT NUMBER D216055664, OF THE PLAT RECORDS OF **TARRANT** COUNTY, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY .271 ACRES OF LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES **EASEMENTS**; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

1. That a portion of West Vickery Boulevard, a variable width public right of way, situated in the Sarah Jennings Survey, Abstract No. 844, as dedicated by Lot 1, Block 1, Jennings North Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Cabinet B, Slide 484 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas and Lot 1, Block 2, Hemphill Lamar Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, according to the plat thereof, recorded under Instrument Number D216055664, of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas, containing approximately 0.271 acres of land more or less, and as more specifically described in Exhibit "A" and "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easements to the land in the above-described vacated street right of way are hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easement be shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
