## SUBJECT

Adopt Two Appropriation Ordinances Increasing Appropriations in the Collective Amount of \$163,482.00 for the Texas Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Department, Internet Crimes Against Children Grant and the Texas Office of the Attorney General, Victim Coordinator Liaison Grant (VCLG) Awarded to the Fort Worth Police Department for Fiscal Year 2019. (ALL COUNCIL DISTRICTS)

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Adopt the attached ordinance for the Texas Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Department, Internet Crimes Against Children Grant increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Grants Operating State Fund in the amount of \$79,482.00 subject to receipt of the grant.
- 2. Adopt the attached ordinance for the Texas Office of the Attorney General, Victim Coordinator Liaison Grant (VCLG) increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Grants Operating State Fund in the amount of \$84,000 subject to receipt of the grant.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to appropriate grant funds for applications authorized prior to Fiscal Year 2020 budget development. The following grants have been authorized for application and execution under M&C G-19570 and C-29089 but still require approval of an appropriation ordinance.
