SUBJECT

Authorize Execution of a Contract with Gibson & Associates, Inc., in the Amount of \$411,258.05 for 2020 Bridge Rehabilitation at Eighteen Locations (COUNCIL DISTRICTS 2, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9)

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the execution of a contract with Gibson & Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$411,258.05 for 2020 Bridge Rehabilitation Contract 1 at eighteen locations.

DISCUSSION:

This contract provides for the repair and rehabilitation of eighteen bridges listed on the attachment provided. The major bridge repairs and rehabilitations include approach slab replacement, deck overlay, structural repair, metal beam guard fence repair and guardrail end treatment replacement (City Project No. 102334).

Construction for this project is expected to start approximately March 2020 and to be completed by approximately August 2020. Upon completion of the project there will be no anticipated impact on the general fund operating budget.

This project was advertised for bid on September 26, 2019 and October 3, 2019 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On October 24, 2019, the following bids were received:
