(CD 8 and CD 9) Authorize Execution of a Contract with Advanced Paving Acquisition, Ltd., in the Amount of \$850,650.00 for Hot Mix Asphaltic Concrete Street Rehabilitation 2019-7 at Various Locations

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a contract with Advanced Paving Acquisition, Ltd., in the amount of \$850,650.00 for Hot Mix Asphaltic Concrete Street Rehabilitation 2019-7 (City Project No. 102804) on approximately four lane miles at multiple locations.

DISCUSSION:

In the Fiscal Year 2020 Pay-Go Contract Street Maintenance Program, various types of street maintenance are grouped into specific contract packages. The recommended construction contract outlined in this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) will provide street rehabilitation for approximately four lane miles at eight street segments under the Contract Street Maintenance Program, as identified in the attached project list and maps (City Project No. 102804).

Construction for this project is expected to start in early 2021 and to be completed by summer 2021. Upon completion of the project there will be no anticipated impact on the General Fund operating budget.

This project was advertised for bid on July 30, 2020 and August 6, 2020 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On August 27, 2020, the following bids were received:
