(ALL) Adopt Appropriation Ordinance in the Amount of \$231,067.55 for the 2017 Railroads Project for Construction Services, Additional Professional Services and City Staff Costs for Safety and Quiet Zone Improvements at Various Railroad Crossings and Amend the FY2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program (2014 Bond Program)

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Adopt the attached Appropriation Ordinance adjusting appropriations in the 2014 Bond Program Fund by increasing appropriations in the 2017 Railroad project (City Project No. 100751) in the amount of \$231,067.55 and decreasing appropriations in the Fund 34014 Appropriation Only project (City Project No. U34014) by the same amount; and
- 2. Amend the FY2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize an additional \$231,067.55 for construction services, additional professional services and City staff costs associated with the 2017 Railroads project. The 2017 Railroads project provides for design and construction of safety and quiet zone improvements at various railroad crossings throughout the City. This additional funding will complete the funding of the 2017 Railroads project from the 2014 Bond Program. The additional funds will come from the 2014 Bond Fund.

Projects location identified intially includes: BSNF at Gordon, BNSF at Townsend, FWWR at 7th Street Preemption Installation, and FWWR at N. Main.

The table below summarizes the past appropriation, its source, the additional funding and the estimated total cost of the project at completion:

Funding for this project was included in the FY2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program in the amount of \$2,665,486.59. Additional funding in the amount of \$231,067.55 is needed for construction services, additional professional services and City staff costs. The action in this M&C will amend the FY2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program.

The above mentioned projects are located in COUNCIL DISTRICTS 2 and 9.
