alignment of the Project;
- the use of the Property will be a public use; and
- the Real Property Division of the Property Management Department is authorized to acquir
by negotiation the Property needed for the Project.
WHEREAS, negotiations between the City of Fort Worth and the property owner, Miranda, Inc
were unsuccessful due to the inability to reach a mutually agreed upon value for the property interest
being acquired by the City of Fort Worth; and
