## AUTHORIZING A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 114 AND DOUBLE EAGLE BOULEVARD ON STATE RIGHT OF WAY WITHIN THE FORT WORTH CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, federal law establishes federally funded programs for transportation improvements to implement its public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Code, Section 201.103 establishes that the State shall design, construct and operate a system of highways and roads in cooperation with local governments, and Section 222.052 authorizes the Texas Department of Transportation Commission to accept contributions from political subdivisions for development and construction of public roads within political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, a Master Agreement between the City of Fort Worth ("Local Government") and the State of Texas acting through the Texas Department of Transportation ("State") has been approved which states the general terms and conditions for Advance Funding Agreements (AFA) for transportation projects and other projects; and

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2019, the State passed Minute Order No. 115550 approving the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth desires to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation in the amount of \$28,756.70 for the purpose of the City furnishing and installing traffic signal equipment on State Highway 114 at Double Eagle Boulevard.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, THAT:

The City Manager is authorized to execute a Reimbursement Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation in the total amount of \$28,756.70 purpose of furnishing and installing traffic signal equipment on State Highway 114 at Double Eagle Boulevard.
