DISCUSSION:

This Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to reject all bids received for combined street reconstruction, drainage, landscaping, illumination, signal and water main improvements for Trinity Boulevard Phase 1, from Interstate Highway (IH) 820 to Salado Trail (City Project No. 102101).

The project was advertised for bid on May 13, 2021 and May 20, 2021 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On June 17, 2021, the following bids were received:

Bids received had costs higher than anticipated. Therefore, staff recommends rejection of all bids. In order to mitigate the schedule impact, the project is currently being re-advertised.
