RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve the conveyance of an easement and right-of-way to Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC, being approximately 0.052 acres, for relocating Oncor electrical lines for future lift station construction near the Village Creek Water Reclamation Facility located at 4500 Wilma Lane, Arlington, TX 76012 owned by the City of Fort Worth; and

2. Authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute and record the appropriate instruments.

DISCUSSION:

As part of the City of Fort Worth's South Influent Lift Station Project (P100075-2 VCWRF), Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC (Oncor) electrical lines must be relocated underground within the area of construction for the City of Fort Worth's new lift station located at the Village Creek Water Reclamation Facility (VCWRF). Therefore, an easement and right of way granted by the City of Fort Worth to Oncor is needed to complete the relocation of the Oncor electrical lines.
