Ordinance No.

AN ORDINANCE REALLOCATING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND BY DECREASING THE GENERAL OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE CATEGORY IN NON-DEPARTMENTAL BY \$167,000.00, AND INCREASING THE SALARIES AND BENEFITS CATEGORY IN CITY MANAGERS OFFICE BY THE SAME AMOUNT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING COSTS OF CITY CONTRIBUTIONS FOR CITY COUNCIL AIDES/DIRECTORS WHO BECOME PARTICIPATING MEMBERS OF THE RETIREMENT FUND, WITH SUCH AMOUNT SUBJECT TO REDUCTION TO CONFORM TO FINAL FIGURES CALCULATED AFTER INDIVIDUALS HAVE MADE THEIR ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; MAKING THIS ORDINANCE CUMULATIVE OF PRIOR ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the budget of the City of Fort Worth for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, as enacted by Ordinance 25073-09-2021, as amended, is hereby further amended to make the following adjustments in the General Fund for the purpose of funding costs of city contributions for the City Council Aides/Directors who become participating members of the Retirement Fund: decrease the General Operating and Maintenance category of Non-Departmental by \$167,000.00, and increase the Salaries and Benefits category in City Manager's Office by the same amount, with the amount subject to reduction to conform to the final figures calculated after all individuals have made their elections, .

SECTION 2.

That should any portion, section or part of a section of this ordinance be declared invalid, inoperative or void for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way impair the remaining portions, sections, or parts of sections of this ordinance, which said remaining provisions shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance shall be cumulative of Ordinance 25073-09-2021 and all other ordinances and appropriations amending the same except in those instances where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with such other ordinances and appropriations, in which instance said conflicting provisions of said prior ordinances and appropriations are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
