Robert Sturns, Economic Development and John Karas and Jennifer Todd with TIP Strategies presented an update and review of the Economic Development Strategic Plan.

5. Presentation on the Recommended Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Budget - David Cooke, City Manager

City Manager David Cooke presented the Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Budget. The budget is 1.8 billion dollars. The proposed tax rate is \$0.7475 with \$0.5950 going to Operations and Maintenance (O&M) and \$0.1525 going to Debt Service. Of the \$0.5950 going to O&M, \$0.5300 will go to Operations and \$0.0650 will go to Capital. There will be a total of 114 net new positions.
